A. City of Flint

He states that the IT Director will not return his calls. Currently we are manually entering EMS calls for the City. The Board feels this is jeopardizing the safety of our citizens.

MILLER TO SEND THE CITY OF FLINT A LETTER EXPRESSING THE NEED FOR AN UPDATE BY APRIL 8TH AS WELL AS SUBSTANTIAL MOVEMENT BY THE SAME DATE AS IT RELATES TO THE NEW WORLD INTERFACE AND ENTERING EMS CALLS MANAULLY. IF SUBSTANTIAL MOVEMENT IS NOT MADE THE SERVICE WILL CEASE.

Argentine Lawsuit

The Consortium has been dismissed from this lawsuit although Argentine Township has not.

Reverse Discrimination Lawsuit

Mr. Lattie stated he expects this lawsuit to be dismissed soon.

4. <u>NEW BUSINESS</u>:

A. New MDC / Data Project

The Consultant continues to work on the RFP. There will be a pre-bid conference on April 15, 2013. All other open projects were discussed.

5. OTHER BUSINESS:

A. Advisory Board Report

Mr. Ackley reported that one of the vacant seats on the Advisory Board was filled by the Fenton Township Fire Chief. At this time there is one vacant seat to fill. He also stated that there were two representatives from the Advisory Board at the mass notification vendor demonstrations.

The Committee also discussed the MDC project and permitting the police and fire services to test any potential vendor products before purchasing.

Microphone Fees

As of this date Mr. Ackley is reporting that the Consortium will run out of microphone fee credits in April 2016 with billings going out May 2016.

B. EMS Dispatch

1. CAD to CAD Progress

EMS dispatch is running smooth.

C. Upgrade to Reverse 9-1-1 (Demo's)

There have been four vendor demonstrations for the new mass notification system. There was a diverse group from across the county that sat through two days of demonstrations in which they scored each system. The two companies being considered are Code Red and Everbridge. Not all of the grant funding requested will come through as expected but some funding is still there.
